

Saint Joseph Parish Preschool Registration Check List

At Saint Joseph Parish Preschool, our commitment is to provide a creative learning environment for the young child. Interaction with other children and adults, in an atmosphere of Christian love and concern, promotes the healthy development of each child. Learning experiences and play activities encourage spiritual, intellectual, social and physical growth.

The program is designed to help the child foster a sequence of learning habits, initial adjustment to school, independent learning, daily living skills, and sensory-motor activities; the fundamentals of reading, writing, and number readiness; together with a physical, spiritual, emotional, and social maturity.

Our program emphasizes working together and sharing by using individual responsibility through free play, music, art projects, stories, crafts, dramatic play and age-appropriate books to encourage participation and creativity. The structure and use of specific learning centers within the preschool classrooms enable the teacher to direct activities, but at the same time consider and address individual differences. This hands-on approach provides multi-sensory experiences, which ultimately contribute to the growth and development of the whole child.

To complete and ensure your child's registration for the 2019 – 2020 school year in the Saint Joseph Parish Preschool, the following items must be submitted before registration is complete:

- A completed Registration Form
- A copy of your child's Birth Certificate
- A copy of your child's Baptismal Certificate
- A Non-Refundable Registration Fee of \$75.00
- Complete On-line registration with FACTS for new families or add new child for current families

Please consider the following when registering your child:

- All children must be toilet trained.
- All children must adhere to the birthday date for the appropriate grade-level.
- All children attending Preschool are required by law to have a current physical and immunization record on file.

Registrations will be accepted on a first-come basis after current members of the Saint Joseph Parish School, Saint Joseph Parish Preschool and Saint Joseph Parish have had the opportunity to register. Open Enrollment for new families will begin on January 22, 2019.
